

LVSA Minutes Sept 3, 2008

The newsletter mailing was completed and the call to order by Pres Sebesta at 8PM. Other officers present: VP Carolyn Cain, Sec/Trea Tom Banks, Chief Inst Dan Thomas, Chief Range Officer Bruce Campbell, and BOD Chip Williams. Ten members attended.

The minutes from May 7, 08 were read. M by J York, 2nd Charles Piette to approve as read. VV +.

Treasurer Banks with assistance from Piette reported \$7075.07 in checking, \$2170+ in savings. Membership stands at 274 with 134 paid for '09.

Chief Inst Thomas reported that the junior rifle program will be starting Oct 2 with Dudley Irvine. Pat McCoy reported that the juniors 'brat & burger' feed on June 6 raised about \$975.

Chief Range Of Campbell reported the outdoor range is seeing increased usage, many times when headed out to spray weeds he found the range active. Campbell suggested the Monday night work schedule be changed to "scheduled days, with notification via email". The summer projects completed included: rebuilding the indoor target wall, cutting brush around the indoor range, hauling wood donated by Dan Thomas, staining the picnic tables, grass & weed control & new roof on 200 yard target shed. 36 completed the hunter safety day Aug 23.

Old business 1] The comment period on the Park regulations on concealed carry had been extended and no decision announced to the public. LVSA sent a letter supporting the NRA/ILA modifications. 2] Jack Schooley has not contacted Spriggs that the targets frames are available to haul out of Denver. 3] Pat McCoy drafted a pair of sign layouts for the indoor facility. Cain & Pieracini have contacts that will be asked for quotes. 4] Pat McCoy contacted WY DEQ and was told to run on the Nation Guard ES they included in the lease agreement. 5] The AR's under Mike Pattyn's control for the JR he was working with were returned to Dan Thomas 9/4. 6] Sebesta contacted Ms Clark, WY Military Dept Lands Mgmt on 8-27 and was told she completed an environmental survey after 1st understanding same was not required. "You're OK". 7] The Fremont Co Fair booth didn't happen, 1 response from a Riverton member. 8] Paul Steinkamp installed the new outdoor range sign. It's a great improvement over old weathered unit. 9] Roger Willenbrecht and Larry Davis will chair the sight-in day [9-19]; be sure to get your rifle raffle tickets in. Drawing will be held about 4PM 9-19. 10] York reported he was able to sell the brass that Bryl Nichols sorted; \$350 to juniors which was at least 2x the scrap price. Juniors will need to sort in future if they want the funds. 11] Thomas asked about the 'Tobacco Free' signs for the indoor range. Sebesta to get three for the club.

New business 1] A call for ideas to increase member participation didn't produce. 2] Simkin memorial. M by York, 2nd Lemm that \$250 be sent to the Lions Club as memorial to Jack. VV +. 3] A call for interest to serve on BOD was made, Ex committee will select at the Oct meeting to fill the vacant position. 4] Turkey shoot chairman expected to be Gail Folson. [confirmed 9-7] 5] Discussion held on date to change the outdoor lock in future—Would it be better to go back to the Jan change? Seeing as it is good for next year—we have time to weigh options. 6] Indoor floor paint discussed. A product called Duco is a acrylic polymer that has a 15 year guarantee has been suggested, its available in colors. \$720/ 10 gal. M by York, 2nd Piette to purchase and apply. 7] York has wood ready for pick up that he's willing to donate to club. 8] The upcoming events ie. Sight in, jr class etc, should be advertised in the paper. M by Williams, 2nd York to pay for same. Dan will contact papers and also get some posters to schools. VV+. 9] Dan Thomas suggested that the Cowboy Action group be invited to discussed if there is a way to lessen the 'junk yard' appearance of there target material stored behind the 200 yard berm. 10] Discussion held about broken door at outdoor range. M by Thomas, 2nd to have Spriggs select a new door and install. VV+.
