

## Dec 3, 2008 LVSA Minutes

After preparing the newsletter mailing, the call to order was issued at 7:45PM by President Sebesta. Ex committee present: VP C Cain, Sec/trea T Banks, Chief Inst D Thomas, Range Chief Campbell, & DOB D Irvine. Five members added to the discussions.

The Nov 5<sup>th</sup> minutes were read and correction called for on square footage to be considered for Ecore product. Correct figure closer to 450. M by P McCoy, 2<sup>nd</sup> D Thomas to approve with correction. VV+.

Treasurer Banks reported \$11000 in checking, \$1175 in savings with major expenditures: \$603 for indoor range sign; \$150 NRA dues and \$120 postage. More new members dues being rec'd than renewals. Membership at 235 and 59 sent 'expired' notices with newsletter.

Chief Instructor Thomas reported that LVSA has entries in Inland Empire and International air gun postal matches. He is working with Dave Langerman on dates for Personnel Protection class. Information from sheriffs dept may lead to a second class.

Range Chief Campbell reported that outdoor range shows sign of heavy use. He asked what type of repair club would like to the 200 & 300 meter metal gongs. M by Thomas, 2<sup>nd</sup> D Lemm to have Campbell use best judgment and get them repaired. VV+

OLD Business 1] Dewayne Meadows, Theodore Roosevelt Conservation Partnership, displayed maps and several members took the opportunity to circle area of interest to include in the "User Value Mapping Project". 2] P McCoy was unsuccessful in attempt to contact Steve Mankowski; will keep trying. 3]The sign for the Garfield end of the indoor range is here. The hanging will be 2PM Sat, Dec 6<sup>th</sup>. Charles Piette will advise JoAnn Richardson, the Clark's daughter. 4] Discussion held on another 'last notice' to be mailed or will the newsletter serve? A post card notice will be sent later in Dec. 5] Ron Pieracani told of the trials of getting turkeys for the black powder event. Smith's in Riverton out did the Lander stores; a good time was had by all even tho attendance [12] was down. Tony Larve assisted Ron. Ron suggested a 243, wood, blue, 77Ruger. Sebesta asked if anyone had tried a Weatherby Vanguard, as they have been advertising a \$399 retail. Guns & Goods and the Good Place will have suggestions at the Jan meeting. 4] Lander Rifle Club lease is due. M by McCoy, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Irvine to make a \$7500 payment.
